

Regarding: Coronavirus measures

Dear Parents,

As you know, the current outbreak of coronavirus disease is receiving much attention. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the measures being taken in school.

We are following the guidelines we have been given by the Netherlands National Institute for Public Health and the Environment (RIVM)

The advice at the moment is to focus on hygiene. In practice, this means the following for our school:

- Paying attention to handwashing. Frequent handwashing is important, not only after using the toilet, but also after sneezing or playing outside. We will pay extra attention to this and ensure that children wash their hands regularly throughout the school day.
- This is also something you can pay attention to at home.
- General advice: this is the time of year for picking up coughs and colds. Please instruct your child not to reuse tissues. Use a clean paper tissue each time you blow your nose and after use, throw the used tissue in the bin.
- We will, like you of course, monitor symptoms such as fever, coughing and the like. If in doubt, we will get in touch with you and you are advised to contact your doctor by telephone. Don't send a sick child to school.

Important advice is also to stay calm, keep each other informed and keep a close eye on further developments.

We hope this letter provides sufficient information for the time being.
